Workers' Voice & Labor

Increasing Minimum Wage: <u>Supports</u>\$15-per-hour minimum wage to protect low-wage workers.

Strengthening Unions & Workers: <u>Proposes</u> strengthening the right to organize and instituting paid family leave.

Labor Law Reform: <u>Proposes</u> increasing the earned income tax credit and strong workplace protections.

Public Education: Supports the right to a free, high-quality public education, and proposes increasing resources to close the education achievement gap, improving school facilities, increasing teacher pay and professional development, and ensuring equal access to opportunities.

Early Education: Proposes guaranteed access to free, public, high-quality universal pre-K.

College Affordability: <u>Proposes</u> every American should have the right to a free, high-quality public higher education, including workforce and technical training.

Healthcare & Workplace Safety

Universal Healthcare: <u>Supports</u> a healthcare system where everyone has access to quality, affordable and secure healthcare.

Public Option: Supports a strong public option that aggressively competes with the private insurance marketplace, drives down costs and expands coverage.

Prescription Drug Costs: <u>Supports</u> reducing prescription drug costs, increasing system accountability, and putting patients and doctors—not the drug manufacturers or insurers—in charge of their healthcare.

Opioid Epidemic: <u>Supports</u> incarcerating people from "drug companies conspiring to addict Americans to opioids."

Gun Violence Reform: <u>Proposes</u> establishing universal background checks, banning large-capacity magazines and assault weapons, enacting red flag laws, closing loopholes, creating licensing requirements, and providing resources to communities to reduce gun violence.

Jobs & the Economy

Trump's Tax Cuts for the Wealthy: <u>Supports</u> expanding the earned income tax credit, rolling back the Trump administration's tax cuts and instituting an annual wealth tax.

Social Security: <u>Supports</u> expanding retirement benefits.

Infrastructure: Proposes a \$2 trillion investment to mobilize over \$6 trillion for climate-smart infrastructure, including upgrading infrastructures, clean transportation, community resilience and access to public lands.

Democracy

Voting Rights: <u>Proposes</u> initiating a vote-at-home system by providing voters with postage-paid absentee ballots, and supports election reform legislation advancing the right to vote.

Citizens United: <u>Supports</u> repealing *Citizens United* and instead publicly financing campaigns.

Immigration & DACA: <u>Supports</u> comprehensive immigration reforms, reinstating the Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals and Temporary Protected Status programs, reinvigorating the visa system, investing in smart border security and creating a path to citizenship.

Civil Rights: <u>Supports</u> ensuring justice in our housing, education, access to capital, environmental, agriculture, health and human services programs, and supports ending cash bail, eliminating private prisons and increasing resources for public defenders.
