A State-by-State Guide to State Policy Network Groups

The State Policy Network (SPN) is an umbrella organization of right-wing think tanks and ultra-conservative nonprofits that functions as a clearinghouse for public policy advocacy at the state level. Its far-right policy agenda has given rise to extremism in the Republican Party.

SPN provides academic cover for ALEC bills and court cases (like *Janus v. AFSCME*) that hurt working people. ALEC (American Legislative Exchange) is a bill-mill that develops "model" legislation that benefit corporations and bolster their profits, usually at the expense of workers.

SPN operates in 49 states, Washington, D.C., Puerto Rico, Canada and the United Kingdom. Here is a state-by-state list of SPN policy groups operating in the United States.
